## Our Professional Care

Our Care Homes is registered for provision of Dementia Care.

Residents are welcome on either a long stay basis or for shorter convalescent or respite care (perhaps when a home carer takes a short break or is unavailable for whatever reason).

Our standard of care is regularly monitored by the Care Quality Commission (CQC) and we continuously strive to meet the highest standards.

At St Michaels we understand that every individual is unique and there is no "one-

size-fits-all" care plan. Every resident that comes to live in St. Michaels has a detailed health and wellbeing assessment plus a care evaluation prior to moving in, during which their particular needs and preferences are discussed together with family members and their own GP. We create a bespoke care plan, tailored to suit all personal and specific care requirements.

The suggested care plan is detailed and agreed prior to moving in.

Our wellbeing team regularly review the care and support needs with

family members of residents, bringing in any agreed changes. This practice of regular evaluation allows us to offer residents the most appropriate amount of care as and when they need it.
